



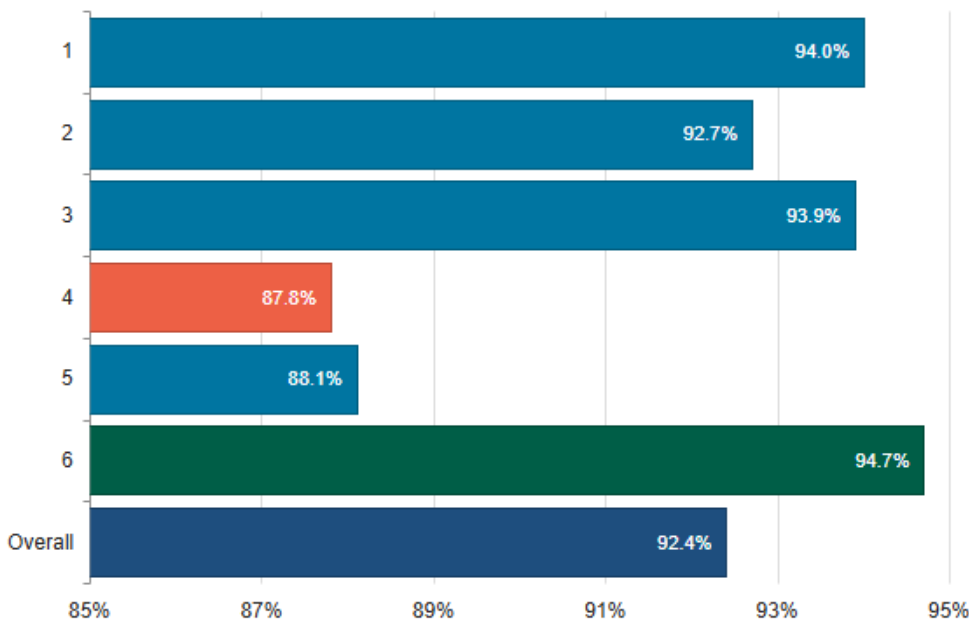
Dear families,
